The search is on for the 2020/2021 Witham Carnival Court. The new Court will be chosen at our Selection Dance on **Saturday 07th March 2020** at the Witham Public Hall, Witham, CM8 2DY, from 6.30pm. Entry is free to the Selection participants and their accompanying parent/guardian. Additional entry tickets can be purchased for £3.00 on entry for adults and £1.00 for children under 13.

The chosen Court will spend a year representing Witham, visiting other towns around our district. This is not a beauty contest but we do look for a pleasant personality, reasonably confident, enjoy meeting people, charismatic and **MUST live in the CM8 postcode area**. During the year they will help raise money for various charities, lead the Carnival Day Procession & attend other carnivals across Essex, London & Kent. **A list of mandatory events is highlighted**. (If you are successfully selected to be part of the 2020/2021 Court you will be asked to sign a disclosure form similar to that below)

- 1 Should you be successful on being selected as part of the 2020/2021 Witham Carnival Court there are some rules that we expect you to follow. This honour brings not only wonderful experiences but also responsibilities. So, this is to go over some of the things you can expect and a few of the very important ground rules.
- 2 First of all, your main responsibility in being the Carnival Court is to represent Witham, the Carnival Committee and yourselves. Make us all proud! Your purpose is to put on a good show for the people of Witham and to raise money for local charities. Remember that you must exhibit good behaviour at all times. You need to be good role models. Remember you are the Carnival Court **24-7** even when you are not on duty. **This includes comments put on social networking sites such as Twitter, Instagram, Snapchat and Facebook etc. Swearing, crude comments or any negative or gossip comments about any part of the Carnival experience are strictly forbidden.** To be part of the Carnival Court requires a commitment to have fun and enjoyment. Should you win awards then this is a bonus but it is not the main theme of being in the Carnival Court.
- 3 Most importantly:
No smoking at any time when on duty.
No swearing.
No drinking alcohol when on duty. This also goes before an event.
No drugs (**if you need to take prescribed medication, let the chaperones know**)
No using mobile phones on the float or when on duty.
Avoid gossip – it will not serve you well nor enhance your experience.

OK, enough of the “NO’s”! Here are some other important “DO’s” that will make your experience even better and safer.
- 4 Listen to your chaperones and follow instructions. Please remember the committee’s decisions are finale.
- 5 Stay together when going on rides and going to the toilet, etc. You will be escorted by the chaperones at all times and cannot go off with friends or family during a sponsored event.
- 6 Build good relationships with the other Carnival Courts. You will see them often throughout the year.
- 7 During a procession, look at people directly, wave and say hello. Be kind to everyone. You might be surprised to see how much this means to people. Always have a smile even though at times you may not feel like smiling.
- 8 **DO NOT BE PROVOKED BY ANYONE** (for example, someone shouting at you whilst on duty). No backchat. Just smile. Your chaperones will deal with this situation and protect you.
- 9 Look people in the eye, speak in more than one word answers and are sociable. This will help you in competitions and will generally enrich your experience.
- 10 There are throughout the year a few competitions that you will be involved in. This includes competitions at other carnivals for best float, Court, etc. We don’t mind if you win or lose so long as you enjoy yourself and have a wonderful time! You will also be invited to functions within the town of Witham. When you attend a Presentation or Selection evening, your own or another Court’s, you will be expected to give a little speech and do a curtsy together. You need to plan with your chaperones what you want to do and say. After you attend your first one, you will see what the other Courts do and will be more at ease with the whole event. There is also dancing at these events and we hope you will participate fully. It makes for a great evening and making friends!
- 11 You must be in full regalia at all times while at an event.
- 12 You will be responsible for maintaining your regalia which will include day/ evening wear, cape, bag and flowers. The chaperones will keep and maintain your crowns and sashes. This just helps prevent someone forgetting them on an event day. If you break, damage or lose any regalia it will be your responsibility to buy new ones.

- 13 We also ask that if you are unable to attend an event, please let your Court Manager know at least 48 hours beforehand so that we can make alternate arrangements. Remember that there are many events that you will be invited to throughout the year and you **MUST ATTEND ALL WITHAM EVENTS.** Any holidays that are booked must be submitted to us with this application. Lastly please be sure that your family knows where you are going and when to expect you back at all times. They are always welcome to attend the Carnivals, etc. Please contact members of the committee for more information.

One parent/ guardian of a court member must attend every away carnival to help drive the Court and help with setting the float up. A rota will be organised so that each parent takes a turn.

- 14 We hope that you find this information helpful. If there are other questions you have about what is involved, please feel free to ask any Witham Carnival Committee member who will be pleased to help.
- 15 **You are requested to bring a packed lunch, change of clothes and money with you when attending other Carnivals.** Your Court Manager will advise you on this.
